ROYAL RECREATION GROUND IMMINGHAM

## BOROUGH OF CLEETHORPES

### BYELAWS

Made by the Council of the Borough of Cleethorpes under Sections 12 and 15 of the Open Spaces Act 1906 with respect to Roval Recreation Ground, Immingham.

### INTERPRETATION

1. In these Byelaws:

“The Council” means the Council of the Borough of Cleethorpes.

“The Ground” means the Roval Recreation Ground Immingham.

### DOGS ON LEADS

2. (1) No person shall, without reasonable excuse, permit a dog to enter or remain in the ground unless the dog is held on a lead and is restrained from behaviour giving reasonable grounds for annoyance.

(2) Notice of the effect of these byelaws shall be given by signs placed in conspicuous positions on the approaches to the ground.

3. (1) For the purpose of these byelaws the keeper of the dog shall be deemed in charge thereof, unless the Court is satisfied that at the time when the dog was present in the grounds without being held on a lead it had been placed in or taken into the charge of some other person.

(2) In paragraph (1) above “the keeper” shall include the owner of the dog or any person who habitually has it in his possession.

### REMOVAL

4. Any person offending against these byelaws may be removed from the Ground by any officer of the Council or any Constable.

5. Any person offending against these byelaws shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level two on the standard scale.
